
C'est pour moi un grand privilège et un

ITTF World Individual Championships May 7-13 2007 in Stockholm, Sweden

We believe in the future...

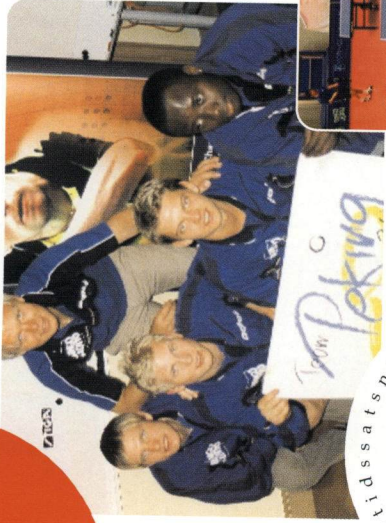
One of the main reasons why the Swedish Tennis Association bids for the WTTC 2007 is our belief in the future for Swedish table tennis.

We have had one of the best teams in the world for many, many years, with of course the shining star Jan-Ove Waldner in top. We are still quite good with five male players ranked among the top 50 in the world. We had three players in the ITTF Pro Tour final in December 2003. Jens Lundquist took an impressive third place.

But we need goals and exciting challenges, a WTTC would be both. Something to gather the table tennis population in Sweden for – a real challenge!

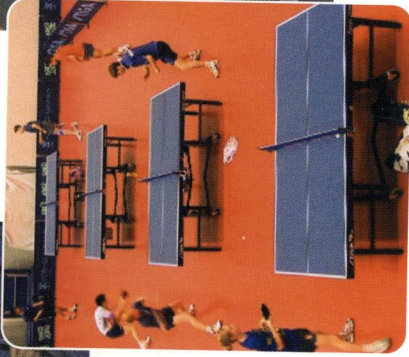
It would also give the next generation of players a possibility to take part in a WTTC on home ground – an exciting challenge and a tempting goal!

Together with the Swedish Olympic Committee and our sponsor STIGA we have just launched "Team Peking" – four young players will have a lot

of extra support and possibilities towards the Olympic Games in Peking (Beijing) 2008. And hopefully, they will get a serious test during the WTTC 2007.

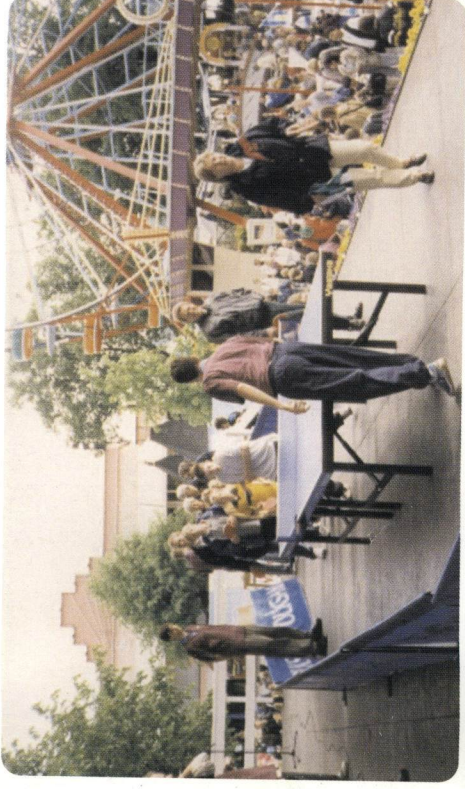
It is also our hope that the Swedish National Training Center in Köping (150 km from Stockholm) established in August 2002 will be a great help not only for young promising male and female players from Sweden, but also to a lot of players from abroad.

The Center is offering the very best international

high quality training. During the first year 20 countries and more than 300 foreign players visited the Center.

22 students take part in daily practice apart from their normal studies at school. As we mentioned in our first Newsletter we have two main options for the Swedish table tennis: One is to form a new generation of top players after Waldner and Persson.

The other option is to be elected as the host for the WTTC 2007.



A few years ago the Stockholm Table Tennis Association. Tried to set a new world record in "Round the table". They nearly succeeded!



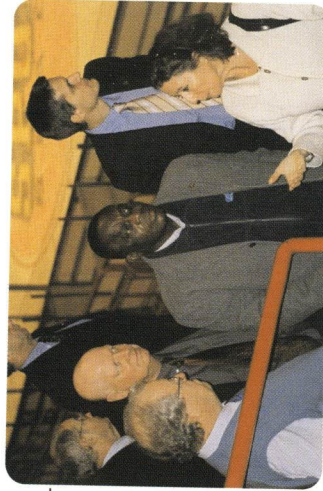
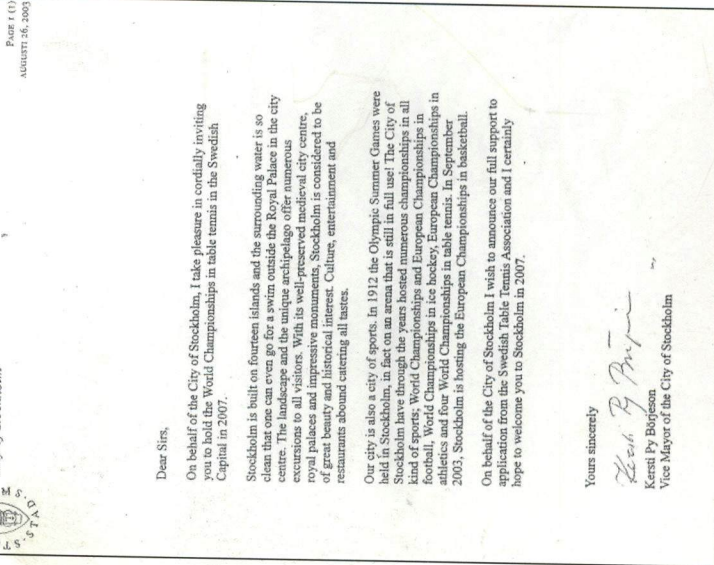

We have named our bid "One Minute Concept" because within the board of STTA, when we decided to bid for a WTTC in Sweden, we all agreed on one very important condition - NEARNESS!

Therefore our choice of Stockholm feel so right - with the fantastic Globe Arenas close to the city centre, close to hotels, excellent communications, etc.

We think it is of great value for a WTTC if we can minimize the time between hotel and venue, between playing halls and practice hall, between hotel/venue and congress centre etc. We are convinced that "One Minute Concept" is the most suitable name for our bid and we hope you will appreciate our efforts and support our request for the WTTC 2007.
