
The Medical Officer in charge of the Mulago Government Native Hospital at Kampala has applied for my assistance in repatriating to their Homes the five undermentioned sick and apparently destitute Barundi:-

1. Kyabulindi s/o Kyabulundi, male, Murundi, 30 years: District: Bisinga; Town: Ngozi; village: Eremali.
2. Petero Migulo s/o Bakundukize, male, Murundi, 25 years; District: Bisinga; Town: Ngozi; Village: Ibon.
3. Musoba s/o Gofovya, male, Murundi, 30 years: District: Kabaleke; Town: Gitega; Village: Ekaluse.
4. Bernardo Manva s/o Bugandaeno, male, Murundi, 20 years: District: Ndiawe; Town: Ngozi; Village: Mututwe.
5. Nviyekule s/o Munyansozi, District ? Nyanza; Town: Nyanza; Village: Ikarama.

2. They all live at considerable distances from Kabale and it is quite impossible for me to arrange their transport from here. I can, however, send them to Ruhengeri and I would be very grateful to know whether you would be able to arrange their transport from your station to the Headquarters of their District of Residence. My Government is willing to pay the cost of their repatriation and should you be able to undertake the transport, would you kindly let me know how much this would cost?

3. The question of repatriating these unfortunate people is one of which presents considerable difficulties and I assure you that any assistance you can give in this matter will be very much appreciated.
